SUMMARY OF RENDEZVOUS EVENTS

Below you will find a summary of events with some hints to help make your stay fun and informative. The enclosed schedule will help you plan each day to maximize your participation in the events of interest to you.

Registration Area: Volunteers will be manning the registration table on the party barges starting at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday and running all day Friday and Saturday morning. Stop by if you have questions, want to post a message or check out the schedule!

Morning Coffee and Donuts: We are providing coffee and famous Lime Kiln Café donuts down at the large party barge starting at 8:00 a.m. both Friday and Saturday. They won't last long, so come on down and greet the morning Roche Harbor style!

Vessel Safety Inspections: Volunteers from the Friday Harbor Power Squadron will be offering free vessel safety inspections both Friday and Saturday. A successful inspection will earn you a sticker for your window that should reduce the chances that you might be stopped by the Coast Guard at a time not of your choosing for an on-the-spot inspection. You can sign up at the registration desk when you check-in, where we also have helpful suggestion sheets available with hints on "How to Survive a Vessel Safety Check".

Women-on-the-Water (WOW) Training: Back by popular demand and thanks to the generous support of NW Explorations, this is an opportunity for the ladies to get some hands-on training in twin-engine maneuvering under the expert tutelage of trainer Paulette Bergh. These two-hour classes are limited to 4 enrollees each class and are free of charge, but required signing up when you registered. All four sessions have been filled for weeks, but we do have a waiting list and will contact those on it should anyone cancel on site. We will be confirming your enrollment when you register and ask that you report to the training vessel, Deception, 15 minutes prior to the start time to ensure the class can begin on time.

Seminars: We've put together a varied schedule of educational talks and seminars, presented by outside professionals as well as some of our own members. These events will be held inside the tents on the docks.
